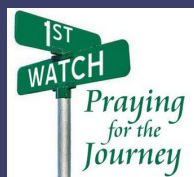


PRAYING FOR MISSIONARIES

What concerns face a missionary? Here are some of the recent special requests we have received.

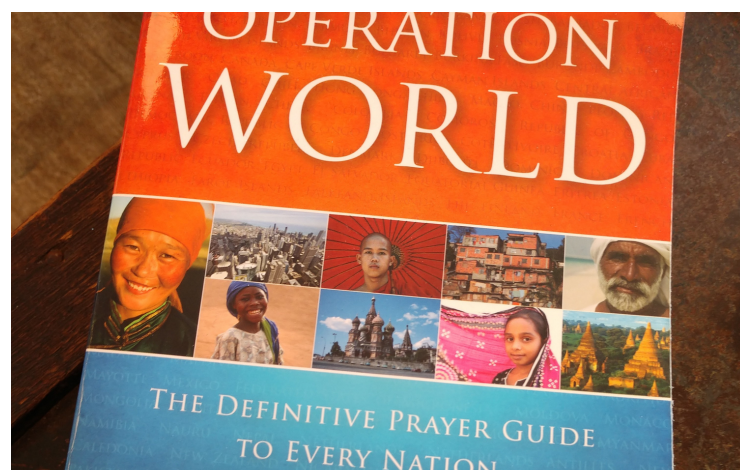
- Rest and reconnection with the Lord. We are very low, just arriving back from the field.
