

Dress Code Policy

The biblical principles of Christlikeness, modesty, purity, and respect are the standards applied. As Christians, our goal is to glorify God in everything and to be an example to those around us.

“Whatever you do, do it all to the glory of God.” *1 Corinthians 10:31*

Representatives of Righteous Rides should respect and honor God, themselves and others in the way they dress. Clothing should be neat, modest, and appropriate; not drawing attention to the body.

General Expectations:

Righteous Rides is a casual, yet professional, work environment. The typical employee wears jeans and a polo or t-shirt.

Overall Dress Code Standards:

- Attire should be clean, modest, and well sized – not too small or tight and not too large
- Tops must cover midriff and bottoms must fit appropriately at the waistline
- No tank tops
- No inappropriate writing
- Shoes should be worn at all times, which may include sandals or leather flip-flops
Closed toe shoes are required inside the Gospel Gearheads Garage
- Clothes should not be frayed or torn

Dress Code for Women

- Tops cannot show undergarments or come off the shoulder; necklines must be modest
- Shorts, skirts, and dresses should not be more than 4” above the top of the knee
- Leggings may only be worn under a dress or tunic
- Fabrics may not be sheer unless an appropriate slip is worn underneath

Dress Code for Men

- Shorts must be no more than 4” above the crease at back of the knee
- Shirts must at least have short sleeves
